'Reasonable Doubt' is considered one of hip hop's all-time classics. Originally released June 25, 1996 by Roc-A-Fella Records, it has been certified Platinum by the RIAA. It earned five mics from The Source and

both Rolling Stone and Blender rank it among their top 500 albums of all time. The album features "Ain't No Nigga" featuring Foxy Brown and "Can't Knock the Hustle" featuring Mary J. Blige as well as guest vocalists Memphis Bleek, Sauce Money and The Notorious B.I.G.
